The Position - The School Board of Rockingham County Public Schools seeks an outstanding educational leader to serve as superintendent. The start date for the new superintendent will be on or before July 1, 2017. Rockingham County Public Schools is an equal opportunity employer.

The Division - Rockingham County is nestled in the heart of the Shenandoah Valley, bounded by two magnificent mountain ranges (the Alleghany and the Blue Ridge) and the impressive Shenandoah River. The current population is 78,593 and Rockingham County is the third-largest county in Virginia by land area. The area is proud of its deep agricultural heritage and boasts diverse outdoor recreation, thriving cultural attractions, vibrant and inviting small towns, and numerous historical attractions. The region is home to James Madison University, Bridgewater College and Eastern Mennonite University.

Rockingham County Public Schools serves over 11,300 students.
