About the Position:

The East Pennsboro Area School District Board of School Directors announces a vacancy for the position of Superintendent of Schools and is commencing a search for a highly qualified individual to lead the school district in this key position.

The Board is seeking a dynamic educational leader with excellent communication skills; a proven track record of improved student achievement; collaborative relationships with faculty, parents and community; fiscal leadership; understanding of and commitment to the district; a focus on equity for all students; integrity, and visionary leadership. The new superintendent will exemplify the District's vision: ***World Class Performers and Productive Citizens.***

Central office experience is preferred.

About the School District:

East Pennsboro Area School District is located in Cumberland County (Intermediate Unit 15) in Central Pennsylvania. Bordering on the Susquehanna River, East Pennsboro Township and the communities of West Fairview, Summerdale, Enola, and parts of Camp Hill comprise East Pennsboro Area School District. The twelve square mile district educates approximately 2700 students in grades Kindergarten through grade twelve in two elementary schools (K-4), a middle school (5-8) and a high school (9-12). The Board approved a \$40.3 million budget for the 2017-18 school year.

East Pennsboro is a suburb of the state capital, Harrisburg, and serves a socio-economically diverse community of more than 20,000 citizens. Although it was once considered a railroad town, the community is now thriving as a center for business and service industries. Corporations including EDS, IBM, Gannett-Fleming, Highmark/Blue Shield, and Metro Bank have regional offices within the township. Holy Spirit Health Care System operates a hospital in East Pennsboro and is joined by numerous physicians, dentists, and medical offices.

Bordering the school district campus is a well-regarded post-secondary school – Central Pennsylvania College. Within a 40-mile radius of the school district, are numerous post-secondary schools including Harrisburg Area Community College, Penn State Harrisburg, Messiah College, Dickinson School of Law, Shippensburg University, Lebanon Valley College, Elizabethtown College, and York College of Pennsylvania. Capital Area Intermediate Unit, which provides special education and support services for the region's 24 school districts, is also located within East Pennsboro Township.

A strong partnership between the school district and the township has created a supportive atmosphere for a dynamic community. New home construction has continued to grow during the past two decades, with neighborhoods attracting affluent buyers and several expanding developments with single homes, townhomes, and condominiums for young middle class and upper middle class families. Excellent municipal services and facilities are also bringing new families and businesses to East Pennsboro Township.

Initial application may be made by submitting a Letter of Interest, a current educational vitae', credentials (letter of eligibility, certification), and three (3) current (within 1 year) letters of reference. Documents should be emailed to:

Applicants who are contacted for an Interview will be expected to complete an Application, provide current Act 34, 114, and 151 clearances, college transcripts and to comply with district policies.

East Pennsboro Area School District is offering a multiyear contract that features a regionally competitive salary and a comprehensive benefits package. Applicants must possess or be eligible for a Pennsylvania Superintendent Letter of Eligibility. Experience as a Superintendent or Assistant Superintendent is preferred as is an earned doctorate or an in-process doctoral program.

The deadline for acceptance of the Letter of Interest and accompanying documents is Wednesday, February 21.

Confidentiality of the applicants seeking this position will be maintained during the initial phases of the application/search process.

Final selection of a superintendent is the responsibility of the Board. An appointment is expected to be made by mid-April 2018.

The anticipated start date for the new Superintendent is July 1, 2018.
